

AGREEMENT FOR HOT TUB USE



1. The hot tub **MUST NOT** be used by any person who:

- Is 7 years old or younger, or under 16 if unsupervised by an adult.
- Is wearing fake tan.
- Has a heart, blood pressure or breathing condition (unless deemed safe by your doctor).
- Takes any medication that makes you drowsy or affects your circulation.
- Has a cut or external infection.

2. **You and your party agree to use the hot tub responsibly, between 6am 10pm**, under the following conditions:

- Only clean swimwear may be worn in the hot tub. No naked bathing please.
- No jumping or diving into the tub.
- No detergents or soaps of any kind to be used in the tub. Please shower before using the tub if you are wearing any make up, moisturiser, sunscreen, insect repellent or other oil-based products and ensure shampoos and body wash are fully rinsed off before use.
- It is recommended that you do not enter the tub if you are alone. If you chose to ignore this advice, please ensure that someone is aware that you are in the tub and how long you intend to spend in it.
- You have discussed the use of the hot tub with your doctor beforehand if you have any medical conditions, are pregnant or are over 60 years old.
- You are aware that the use of alcohol, drugs and certain medication before or during the tub use may lead to a danger of drowning.
- Be aware of the amount of time you are in the tub. Soaking for longer than two cycles (30 minutes) can raise your body temperature and lead to dehydration, dizziness, nausea, fainting or skin reactions. If you wish to soak for longer, take a break before getting back in and drink plenty of water.
- Please use the plastic glasses provided if taking a drink near the spa. No glass or bottles to be taken near the hot tub. No food in the hot tub please.
- The owners have set the water temperature to 38°C and will test conduct daily tests on the spa water, record the results and adjust chemicals, as per the manufacturer's guidelines. If any unsafe readings are found, the hot tub will be closed.
- If any objects enter the water, or if the hot tub is abused or overused (causing the tub water to turn cloudy and rendering the tub unusable), then the spa will need to be drained, cleaned and refilled, for which you agree to pay a £50 refill charge. The spa will take around 12 hours to be ready to use.
- The owners take no responsibility for any skin conditions that may arise from contact with the chemical sanitiser in the water or the spa if used when the water is cloudy or smelling unpleasant.
- Do not sit, stand or place heavy objects on the hot tub cover. Do not allow your dogs to climb onto the hot tub lid. It will break easily if sat on and you agree to cover the cost of a replacement if such damage occurs which is £750.
- No smoking in or right next to the tub.
- No electrical devices except mobile phones near the tub.
- No dogs in the hot tub. Please ensure your dog is tethered if they are likely to want to join you.
- Any issues with the hot tub are to be raised to the owners immediately. Please contact the cottage hosts or 999 (as appropriate) in the event of an emergency.

THE USE OF THE HOT TUB BY ANY MEMBER OF THE RENTAL GROUP IS ENTIRELY AT THEIR OWN RISK.
